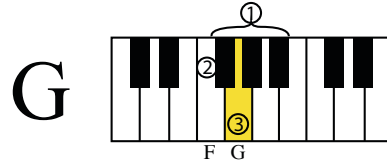


Treble: Play-By-Touch



1. Right hand locates the group of 3 black keys to the right of center F.
2. Finger 1 bumps the left side of the first black key and slides towards you on the F key.
3. Finger 1 plays the next key to the right: G.

1. Write in the beats before playing.
2. Play hands separately as you count aloud.
3. Play hands together as you count aloud.
